## ANOMALOUS SOIL RESULTS INDICATE POTENTIAL VMS MINERALIZATION, SENECA PROJECT

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### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

**Vancouver, British Columbia – April 8, 2015 – NSS RESOURCES INC. (CSE:NSS)** (the "Company") announces that it has received geochemical results from a reconnaissance soil sample survey recently conducted on the SENECA 1 to 9 claims, Harrison Lake area, British Columbia.

A total of 138 samples were collected on a 25m x 100m grid spacing in the north east portion of the property over the SENECA 6, 8 and 9 claims. Results indicate anomalous Cu, Pb and Zn values in soils which are roughly bracketed by previously outlined weak Aeroquest airborne EM conductors, and may indicate the presence of potential VMS mineralization of the Seneca VMS type noted 5km to the southwest.

The NSS Property, covers a total area of 4,124 hectares and surrounds six claims that cover the historical Seneca Deposit and Vent Zone (these six third party claims total 150 hectares, and neither the Seneca Deposit nor the Vent Zone are a part of the NSS Seneca Property). The Seneca Deposit and the general area have been the subject of considerable mineral exploration since the 1920's when Kuroko style massive sulfide Au, Ag, Cu, Pb and Zn mineralization was first discovered. Since then, major mining companies including Noranda, Cominco, Chevron, BP Selco, and Minnova and several junior explorers have at various times held options and explored the claims area. Published historical non NI43-101 compliant resources for the Seneca Deposit are 1.506 million tonnes at 0.82 g/t Au, 41.13 g/t Ag, 0.63% Cu, 0.15% Pb, and 3.57% Zn (see Technical Report on the Seneca VMS Project, British Columbia, dated July 30, 2014, by Donald G. Allen, PEng (B.C.), filed on Sedar).
